Notes

(1) Core Courses (Type 'T')

The core courses are compulsory courses for all candidates who pursue the Master of Counselling coursework programme according to their respective field of specialization in Education.

(2) Elective Courses (Type 'E')

The elective courses are offered under the specialized counselling courses.

(3) Guide to Course Registration

Full Time : Students can take up to 6 courses (19 units) for three consecutive semesters. All courses may be completed in three academic sessions in order to fulfill the requirement for graduation.

Part Time: Students can take only half of Fulltime load, with 3 courses (maximum 10 units) per semester. All courses may be completed in six academic sessions in order to fulfill the requirements for graduation.

(4) Adding / Dropping Course

Students are not allowed to adding/dropping the course until after the completion of course registration activity. Adding/dropping of courses are only allowed after obtaining the support of the Lecturer and approval from the dean/Deputy Dean of the school for valid reasons.

Students who drop the course until 2nd week can claim a refund of tuition fees. However, dropping of courses are still allowed after 2nd week until the 6th week without any refund of fees. After 6th week, students are not allowed to drop any courses.
