

First results of City Human Potential Ranking 2023 announced

We are proud to announce the first results of the City Human Potential Ranking 2023.

The ranking was created using the UNESCO methodology by an international group of researchers from 8 universities (from India, Malaysia, Argentina, Philippines, Indonesia, etc.) under the auspices of the Panamerican University (Mexico).

The City Human Potential Ranking evaluates the human potential of the 100 largest cities from 32 developing countries (BRICS+) on the basis of 197 primary indicators and 30 complex indicators in 3 categories (“Education”, “Labor market”, and “Technologies”). The ranking is based on two complementary dimensions of analysis: “People for the city” (evaluating the quality and prospects for the development of population’s potential), and “City for the people” (evaluating the opportunities provided by the city institutions for the development and realization of population’s potential).

Prof. Hazri Jamil, from School of Educational Studies, Universiti Sains, Malaysia, was one of the leading experts of the Ranking research team. Thus, we have been honored by the right to publicly announce the first results of the Ranking.
